3. National Workshop on FNA Cytopathology Successfully Held at CUVAS

The Central Diagnostic Laboratory (CDL) of Cholistan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences successfully organized a high-impact one-day national workshop titled “*Fundamentals of Fine Needle Aspiration (FNA) Cytopathology for Thyroid and Breast Lesions: Hands-on Training in Basic Diagnosis*” on May 21, 2026. The workshop was held at the Central Diagnostic Laboratory with the aim of enhancing practical diagnostic skills and bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-time laboratory applications in both human and veterinary pathology. The workshop was organized under the patronage of Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Muhammad Tariq Javed, while Prof. Dr. Muhammad Mazhar Ayaz represented him as Patron-in-Chief. The event was led by Dr. Hafiz Iftikhar Hussain along with the CDL organizing team. The workshop attracted approximately 130 participants including BS, M.Phil., and PhD scholars, faculty members, veterinary medical officers, and researchers from different institutions. Renowned experts including Prof. Dr. Muhammad Mudassar Majeed and Prof. Dr. Riaz Hussain delivered comprehensive lectures and practical demonstrations on Fine Needle Aspiration Cytopathology for thyroid and breast lesions.

Participants received hands-on laboratory training using advanced microscopy systems integrated with high-definition digital imaging and live projection technology. The practical sessions enabled students and researchers to observe real-time diagnostic procedures, cytology slide interpretation, and laboratory techniques in detail. Interactive discussions and question-answer sessions further enhanced the academic value of the workshop. The participants highly appreciated the initiative and recommended the continuation of such advanced technical workshops to strengthen research capacity, diagnostic expertise, and professional skills in veterinary and medical sciences.
